



Enabling Settings Lockout on Android 5+ Devices

Due to a change in the permissions structure from version 5 onwards, additional permissions need to be manually granted to the DSA Player (formerly Standby Player) when using the *Settings Lockout* feature. Follow the steps below to enable settings lockout :


1. Install DSA Player 1.2.8 or later.




2. Access the settings menu by pressing and holding the Vol- key while DSA Player is running. Enter the location code.

If the device does not have a Vol- key then use a file manager to delete the file security.txt in the standbyplayer folder. Then stop and start the player app to access the settings menu.


3. In the Settings menu tick Settings Lockout.



4. Click OK to modify permissions.




5. A list of Apps / permissions is displayed including the DSA Player




6. Slide the DSA permission setting to ON.

7. Click YES to the "App usage access" message



8. At this point use the back button / soft key to go back to the DSA settings menu.



9. Finally click *Save* to retain these settings and resume the player.
